

Feeding Rates

Mixing in with the rations is the recommended feeding method. If mixing is impractical then feed daily on an ad lib basis.

Dairy Cows - Feed according to yield

Litres	Grams/head/day (*)	Fully Mineralised Diet Grams/head/day (*)
4500/5500	100/120	50/60
5500/7000	120/150	60/75
7000/8500	150/180	75/90
8500/10,000	180/220	90/110
over 10,000	220/250	110/125

(*) If maize or similar mineral deficient forage is fed increase inclusion rate by 50 grams/head/day

Dry cow/pre-calving:

Start 6 weeks before calving 120-150 grams/head/day

Bulling Heifers:

Start 6 weeks before bulling 130 grams/head/day

Beef Cattle

Maintenance	75-100 grams/head/day
Dry cow/pre-calving:	Start 6 weeks before calving 120 - 150 grams/head/day
Bulling Heifers:	Start 6 weeks before bulling 130 grams/head/day

Calves/Young stock

Maintenance	0.05% of bodyweight per day
At times of stress	0.1% of bodyweight per day
Example - A Calf weighing 100kgs (2cwt) feed 50 grams/day for maintenance & 100 grams/day at times of stress.	

Sheep and Goats

Ewes	60-70 grams/head/day - start 6 - 4 weeks before lambing and continue for 3 - 4 weeks after lambing.
Rams/Tups	90-120 grams/head/day

Typical challenges

Dairy Cows – High cell counts and poor fertility

Suckler Cows – Weak calves and poor fertility

Ewes & Lambs – Orf and weak lambs

Calves – Ring worm

Overcoming nutritional deficiencies

The effectiveness of the digestive process in the rumen influences the level of nutrition the animal is able to obtain. Unbalanced rations and poor availability of trace minerals, rather than a lack of them, will adversely affect microbial efficiency and often result in animals being clinically or sub-clinically nutritionally deficient. As a result immune systems are impaired and the animals are unable to overcome the challenges put upon them.

Lower Cell Counts – 1000 cow result

A farm based trial in 2008 involving 5 herds and over 1000 cows recorded a significant drop in cell counts over 3 month feeding period.

Iodine - A lack of iodine in soils and forage is recognised to be a problem for many livestock enterprises. EC Feed Regulations limit the amount of iodine that can be added artificially to bought in feed stuffs. However Seaquim Elite and Asco Marine Meal are **naturally high in iodine**.
